CPHS GENERAL SUPPLY LIST (Virtual and In-Person)

ORGANIZATIONAL HELPERS

- A sturdy clear or mesh backpack (due to space considerations rolling backpacks are permitted with a doctor's note on file in the front office.)
- A combination lock (may purchase at CPHS). Students will share the combination with their homeroom teacher.
- Several three-ring binders (Some teachers require a dedicated binder exclusively for their class.)
- Pencil case that fits in a binder
- Binder dividers

BASIC "ENDLESS" SUPPLIES

- Pencils (no.2 and or mechanical)
- Pens
- Loose-leaf notebook paper (most teachers ask that students use the college-ruled variety.)

NICE TO HAVE
